We have exercised the option to purchase the hangars! Escrow has closed and we now have a monthly mortgage payment. Although the mortgage is for five years, our goal is to pay off the loan as early as possible. We are currently working with the City of Salem on the Assignment of Lease to transfer the property lease agreement to the club.

# Fuel surcharge update



The price of 100LL at Salem has remained at \$7.15/gal, which is above the updated budgeted threshold for adding the fuel surcharge. The fuel surcharges for March will continue to be:

Skyhawks/Cherokee: \$3.14/hr Skylane: \$4.81/hr

# Fuel prices can be lower elsewhere



The price of 100LL at Salem has remained significantly higher than many other local airports.

Here are some examples

of local prices:

Salem: \$7.15/gal Lebanon: \$5.75/gal Twin Oaks: \$5.90/gal Mulino: \$6.19/gal Albany: \$6.39/gal Independence: \$6.60/gal

Fueling up at one of the alternate airports can save between \$4/hr and \$18/hr! We can use those savings to keep our rates low.

You can use <a href="www.airnav.com">www.airnav.com</a>, Garmin Pilot, Foreflight, or other tools to check current local fuel prices (some airports are *more* expensive than KSLE). Thank you for helping to keep our costs down!

The weather was perfect all day, with clear blue skies and not much wind, although there was a little light turbulence in places over the Gorge. Two aircraft went VFR; I filed IFR and ATC routed us over PDX and well off the direct route to KYKM.

tours and they weren't able to accommodate us. We went around the local airport museum instead, the McAllister Museum of Aviation, which is right beside the CubCrafters factory. The museum has a variety of aircraft, engines, and displays about specific pilots and episodes in aviation history. Our guide also took us back out onto the ramp to point out some of the CubCrafters factory aircraft sitting there, in various stages of readiness to fly.



When it came to lunchtime, we discovered that the airport restaurant, Reno's on the Runway, is closed at weekends because they have an active catering business that takes priority.
