PIREP: Verkehrshaus der Schweiz

On a recent family trip to Switzerland, I had the pleasure of visiting the Swiss Museum of Transport in Lucerne. The museum includes sections for air, space, rail, road, and cableway transportation, along with additional areas reminiscent of OMSI. I spent most of my time in the air transport section.

One major display gives a detailed history of the Swiss airborne rescue service, Rega. I counted at least four models of helicopter used for mountain rescue and medical transport over the years, plus a Storch airplane and Challenger jet air-ambulance. In addition to helicopter mountain rescues in the Alps, Rega uses jet air ambulances anywhere in the world to repatriate citizens if they cannot obtain adequate care where they become sick or injured.

The museum has a variety of interesting artifacts, including a capsule used by Felix Baumgartner for preliminary jumps of the Red Bull Stratos program. In 2012, he rode an identical twin of the capsule to the stratosphere, suspended from a balloon. After rising to 127,851 feet, Baumgartner set altitude and speed records with his jump, reaching Mach 1.25, propelled only by gravity.



I was particularly taken with the only remaining Lockheed Model 9 Orion, a single engine, single pilot airplane from the early 1930s that was very fast for its time. Swissair flew them in passenger service from 1932-1936. The airplane on display is now in Swissair livery, however it was owned by Shell Aviation in the mid-1930s and flown frequently by Jimmy Doolittle.
