PIREP: Florence (6S2) flyout

At first it looked as though our planned flyout to Florence (6S2) was going to be another washout. The morning started with low clouds sitting over most of the valley, with forecasts suggesting they'd clear sometime in the late morning.



We met for breakfast at the Flight Deck, anyway, figuring we could at least talk flying if we couldn't actually go flying. While we ate, we kept an eye on the weather, and by the time we were wrapping up the ceilings had indeed begun to lift.

Seven of us departed in three aircraft and headed south. Near Corvallis the coastal layer broke apart, giving us a clear path to turn southwest toward Florence. The day had flipped from marginal to ideal, with smooth air all the way across the Coast Range.

After landing, we walked the mile or so into town for something to eat. While some of us stuck to coffee and snacks, others went all in on clam chowder. With the delayed start, time was short, so once we were done, we retraced our steps back to the airport and headed back to Salem.



For several people, it was their first landing at Florence. The field has a courtesy car, but it's also an easy walk to the waterfront under the bridge, where there are plenty of food options. The day ended up being a great flyout that almost didn't happen!



N5174E paint update

N5174E's paint job is nearly complete, and the aircraft will be ready to be picked up mid-December. A detailed summary of the upgrades will be included in the January newsletter once 74E is back in Salem.

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We ask that all members please take special care of the plane to protect the new paint job!

 A fueling wing mat has been purchased and will be in 74E. This mat must be used during fueling to protect the leading edge.





- Please be sure to thoroughly clean the leading edges, struts, and cowling after each flight.
- Please remember that it is still an older airframe and we need to be careful with the doors (opening, closing, and locking), seat mechanisms, and other aspects of the plane.
- Please report any damage noted to the paint.

KSLE Fuel Discount

When submitting your fuel expenses for fuel purchased at Salem, please remember to do the following to help us with the fuel refund from Salem Aviation Fueling:

- When purchasing fuel at KSLE: Enter the full Aircraft Tail number in the pumps when you purchase fuel at KSLE (e.g., 5174E, 70574).
- When checking your flight into Flight Circle:
 - Enter each fuel expense separately and upload an image of each fuel slip. Flight Circle allows you to enter multiple fuel reimbursements for each flight. If you purchased fuel at multiple locations, please do not mix KSLE fuel reimbursements with those from other airports.
 - Enter KSLE as the fueling location for each fuel purchase made at Salem.

Local fuel prices update

The price of 100LL at Salem is currently \$5.95/gal, and there will be no fuel surcharge for December.
